If the first decade of the Del Mar Foundation was Del Mar Days, picnics, and expanding the Summer Twilight Concerts, the second decade from 1992-2002 saw the addition of the Cultural Arts Committee and the popular First Thursdays subscription series plus the establishment of the incredible Children's Committee which sponsors civic parades, holiday parties, and other cultural activities for children.

Just as vital as these programs are, so too is the grant money which the Del Mar Foundation has made available to groups with a great idea. Some of those ideas come from the members themselves. Barbara Harper and other Board members had a dream that the run-down Powerhouse could be renovated to be a community center. And so it happened with the Del Mar Foundation acting as a fiscal sponsor for the renovation and the eventual founding of the non-profit Friends of the Powerhouse. Where would we be without the Powerhouse today, not to mention smart, energetic people like those involved?

And speaking of great ideas, seed money is always important. In 2000 Nancy Weare and Mary Ann Emerson, also former Board members, saw a need for an organization to serve our 55+ community. They came to the Del Mar Foundation with a budget to fund a start-up, which would later become Del Mar Community Connections. Del Mar Foundation is proud to have the resources and be ready to help when the community has a need!

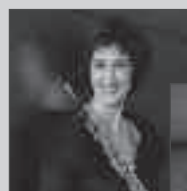

## President's Corner

Dear Friends and Neighbors,

On March 31 the Del Mar Foundation celebrated 30 years of history with Joel Holliday and Lou Terrell, both past Presidents and founding members of the Del Mar Foundation. Together Joel and

Lou shared the history of the Foundation dating back 30 years, acknowledging the efforts of the 38 past and present Board Directors in the audience, four City Council Members, numerous volunteers and a host of major donors. Their vision for the Foundation, including a community endowment, summer concerts in Seagrove Park, support for the cultural arts, and the retention and restoration of open space for future generations has become a reality.

In celebration of the Del Mar Foundation's 30th Year Anniversary, this very special event was highlighted with a Proclamation from Adam Kaye, on behalf of Pam Slater-Price and the San Diego County Board of Supervisors, honoring the Del Mar Foundation and declaring March 31, 2012 as Del Mar Foundation Day.

One hundred and thirty Del Mar residents celebrated with an 80's dress and décor theme, along with wonderful music from well known Del Mar resident and musician Bert Turetsky. The history

of the Foundation and the Foundation's role in the community was well preserved and illustrated with a video and photos chronicling 30 years.

As we look forward to funding significant community grants this year and over the next 30 years, our goal is to continue to increase the Community Endowment to \$1 million by the end of 2012. With a total of over \$600,000 in endowment assets through March 31, 2012, and a fund raising effort for the 30th Anniversary Endowment Campaign well underway, we are close to achieving our goal.

Contributing both time and treasure to build a lasting legacy for future generations is a community challenge. In 2011 the Del Mar Foundation introduced a Legacy Planning Program to facilitate donors who wish to consider the Foundation as part of their legacy planning. With the estate and transfer tax limits expected to change, we hope to see a number of donors increase their charitable contributions to take advantage of current tax laws prior to year-end.
